PLARN YARN...What is that?

It is plastic grocery bags that have been cut and turned into "yarn". Yes, plastic yarn. It is a wonderful way to recycle bags and help the homeless at the same time. Betty Michael brought this concept to Main Street and we quickly picked up the project through our Helping Hands Ministry.

While visiting Florida last year and seeing so many homeless people, she asked the Lord to lead her to something that she could do to help them. Sure enough, the very next day she read about a project that had started in Florida to create mats to give to the homeless so they would not have to lie on bare, hard surfaces. The mats are made from plastic bags that are folded, cut, tied together and then crocheted into 6 x 3 mats. These

mats can be rolled up and easily carried from place to place by those folks who need them. They provide a dry, fairly comfortable surface on which to lie.

In addition to the Helping Hands ministry adopting this project, Betty asked another church member, Sarah Catlett, if she would be interested in having her students at Kings Fork Middle school participate. Sarah said yes, and the students are now involved in "Operation Bedroll". A local senior living complex, Lake Prince Woods, has also become involved in making the bedrolls. Operation Bedroll is now being started at other churches too.

What a wonderful ministry! In addition to helping people in need, many people are able to be involved in the process.

How can you be involved? Save your bags, learn how to cut and tie the bags and then crochet them together. As keepers of God's earth, we are also keeping the bags out of the landfill.

Thank you Betty for responding to a nudge from God!


RISE AGAINST HUNGER FOOD PACKAGING EVENT [OCTOBER 20, 2018]

[WEDNESDAY EVENINGS @ 7 PM]


