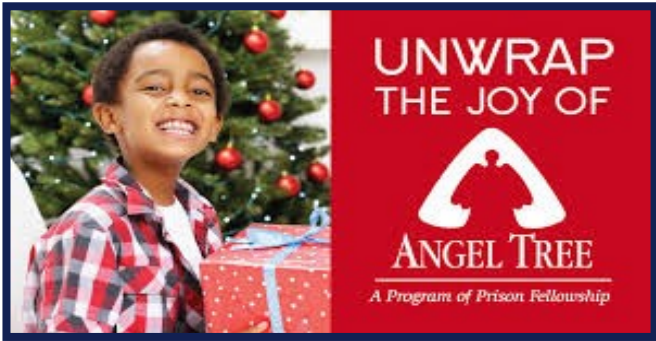

### Ring the Bell

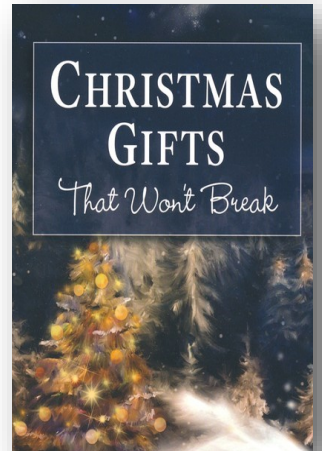
#### FOR THE SALVATION ARMY AT WALMART
